

Using Vogue's theme settings: Color

Virtually every color in Vogue is customizable, with clear labels in the **Color** portion of the **Theme settings**. These settings are organized into four categories:

- **General**
- **Sidebar and alternate header**
- **Product listings**
- **Collection colors.**

Access the **Colors** settings

1. In the theme editor (**Customize**), click **Theme settings**
2. Open **Colors**

Selecting colors

Click on the swatch to edit the colors. A popup with a color selector will appear, allowing you to adjust and test out custom colors.

Collection colors

Vogue allows you to assign a specific color to each of your collections, which will display wherever a collection is featured, as well as on the collections page.

Default collection color

If a particular collection is not included in these settings, the **Default collection color** will display in its place. Select a color for this setting by clicking the rounded-rectangle swatch.

Assign colors to collections

Starting with **Collection 1**, choose the collection by clicking **Select collection**.

Then use the rounded-rectangle **Color** swatch to select the collection's custom color.


