


# Vogue sections: Slideshow

Vogue features a dynamic **Slideshow** section to showcase their most recent deals and top-selling products with videos and images. Create up to six slides—each with a unique image, message, and link.



Add **Slideshow** to your home page

1. In the theme editor (**Customize**), click **[+] Add section**
2. Locate **Slideshow**
3. Click the section, then **Add**
4. **Save**

## Auto-rotate the slides

---

For the slideshow to play automatically, enable **Autoplay slideshow**. Customize the **Autoplay slide duration** using the provided slider. If disabled, customers can still click through your slides using the slide pagination at the bottom of the section.

## Add an overlay

---

To use an overlay, a semi-transparent color masking the image, make sure that box is checked. This feature helps to increase the contrast between the text and its background.

Customize the color of this overlay from the **Style** dropdown and the **Opacity** using the provided slider.

## Creating the slides

---

Under **Content**, begin by clicking on a **Slide** to expand its settings.

### Include a video

---

Add an optional **Video background URL** to feature videos as a slide. Enter the link to a YouTube video to the labeled field.

### Add your image

---

Upload a **Cover image** by clicking **Select image**.

Images with larger dimensions (**1400 x 800px** or larger) are ideal for this section.

### Adjust the image's focal point

---

Customize the **Image position** using the provided dropdown. This shifts the center of the image to reposition the image's subject(s) within the container.

### Add the text

---

Include a **Heading**, **Subheading**, **Button link**, and **Button label** using the provided text fields.

### Position the text

---

Use the **Text position** dropdown to change where the text is placed on the slide image or video.
